


HERE BE FLAGONS

What can we offer?

- Event music For weddings, Birthdays, Parties etc
- **School visits** Half day sessions in line with KS2 curriculum providing talks on history and period music
- **Interactive displays** Opportunities for the public to play ancient musical instruments
- **Drumming workshops** 20 minute sessions of a fun an enthusiastic introduction to drumming with Shamanic skin drums
- Engaging instrument talks and demonstrations with encouraged audience participation
- **A rare trio of recreation Carnyces** *Iron age war horns* based on the Deskford and Tintignac excavations. Demonstration and talks.
- **Versatility** to align specifically with individual periods as required for event/site however this can limit what is on offer to the public.
- Full period costume We are able to adorn ourselves in Iron age, Roman, Early Saxon and Migration period clothing with current display and equipment.



Examples of Instruments

- Palaeolithic, Mesolithic, neolithic Bone flutes, Bone Percussion, Bull-roarer, Conch/Seashell-horn, Blowing-horn, Ocarina, Skin Drums.
- Iron Age & Roman Carnyx, Lituus, Cornu, Tuba, Cymbalum, Cymbala, Crotalum, Crotala, Syrinx, Sistrum, Tympanum, Clappers, Scabellum, Pandura/Lute, Bells.
- Saxon Lyre, Harp, Shawm, Smallpipes, Bells.
- Viking Lur, Tagelharpa, Jawharp, Pibgorn, Troll Rattle, Kantele, Jorvik Pipes.
- Medieval Triangles, hog-nosed psaltery, Lute, Rebec, Buisine.
- **Renaissance and beyond** Crumhorn, Gemshorn, Hurdy-gurdy, Mandolin.
